**OUR MISSION** is to provide emergency financial assistance to residents of Frederick County. In the past 12 months, we have assisted almost 1600 families and individuals meet essential human needs.

- 415 received housing assistance (avoiding evictions, gathering security deposits, emergency housing/motels)
- 593 were helped to avoid cutoff of essential utilities (electric, heat, water)
- 195 were assisted with prescription and other medical bills
- 293 received Maryland photo IDs or birth certificates, essential documents in today's world, that they could not afford
- Others received help with funerals, bus tickets, work related or other expenses
- Information about and referrals to other Frederick County governmental and non-profit organizations was provided to all who would benefit.

Quarterly, we assist Society of St. Vincent de Paul Conferences in financially challenged areas, one in West Virginia and one in Peru.

Our office is located on the campus of St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Frederick. Members are on site and available from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Weekend contact is also available.

Our conference is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, staffed entirely by volunteers, and funded primarily by contributions to six Catholic parishes in Frederick County. 96% of contributions go directly to assisting needy individuals and families.
