- Bins with supplies have been placed outside of the kitchen area in the alcove near the tables for coffee and donuts along with more detailed instructions.
- Please wear your nametag while serving – nametags can be found in the binder near the bins.
- For safety reasons, children under 12 are not permitted in the kitchen. Children 13-17 are permitted with adult supervision.
- Donuts and donut holes are currently provided by Maggie’s Bakery. Please put 4 or 5 donut holes in a cup & set out w/donuts.
- Make 40 cups of coffee at the 9:00 Mass using 2.5 cups of coffee. Plug the coffee pots in using the outlets near the bins and then roll the cart of coffee and hot water in to the legacy room and plug in to those outlets. (Using the outlets in the legacy room initially could result in tripping the circuit breaker.)
- 11:00 Mass Volunteers, can you please check the supplies and replenish, as needed.
- Even when not scheduled, take a moment to check into the kitchen to see if coffee has been made and donuts delivered before entering Mass. This helps to be sure that everything is going as planned.
- **If you cannot attend on your given date, please switch with someone on the list and let me know of the change so that phone and/or email reminders go to the correct family. The complete member listing is attached and email addresses have been provided to help with this.**
- If your name is on the schedule twice then next time it will only be on once.
